"Living Water – The Only Way..."

Mike's sermon last Sunday was based on the 3F challenge: Find Life, Forsake Idols and Follow Jesus.

Among the points he made were the following:

- We must forsake unrighteousness with undivided hearts;
- An idol is anything that takes God's place;
- God must take precedence over everything;
- We have a tendency to rebel against God;
- Rebellion is as serious as witchcraft;
- Secular humanism says there is no God;
- Jesus says "I am the Way";
- Jesus is all we need;
- Like the disciples we must forsake all idols;
- Everyone is born in God's image;
- We all have a spiritual thirst that needs assuaging;
- The only way is living water in Jesus;
- We drink by believing in Him.

Mike concluded by saying that all believers are given the blessing of the Holy Spirit.
