# Introducing



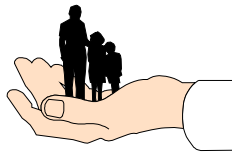
## Welcome to Charlton & Blackheath Christian Fellowship (CBCF)

We are a group of Christians from all walks of life who believe that God has called us to meet together in this part of South East London.

**God's Word** We believe that God's word, written in the Bible, is the truth revealed through the Holy Spirit and we have found that it is relevant to us today, even though some of it dates back 3500 years. Regular preaching and teaching from the Bible plays an important part in our Fellowship life.

**BSL Interpretation** is usually provided at our Sunday morning Celebration and one of our home groups is 'signed'.

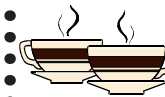
## SUNDAY MEETING
