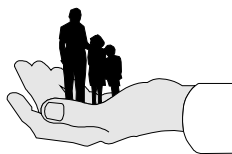
Welcome to Charlton & Blackheath Christian Fellowship (CBCF)

CBCF supports Greenwich Foodbank and there is a collecting box for food items at the back of the hall during our services

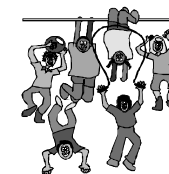
