I am more than a conqueror, an overcomer, because my victory is in Jesus and His grace is sufficient for me. (Romans 8:37, 1 John 5:4, 2 Cor 12:9)

As I walk by faith I have boldness and access with confidence.
(2 Cor 5:7, Ephesians 3:12)

The Spirit of the sovereign Lord is upon me and He has anointed me. (Isaiah 61:1)

I stand in His grace and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God.
(Romans 5:2-3)

The love of God has been poured out in my heart by the Holy Spirit. (Romans 5:5)
